Who Is Eligible?

Patients may be eligible for the Bayer US Patient Assistance Foundation free drug program if they:

- ✓ Live in the United States or Puerto Rico
- ✓ Meet the income eligibility requirement of at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) for most Bayer prescription medicines
- ✓ Don't have insurance or don't have insurance coverage for their prescribed Bayer medicine

- Vitrakvi® (larotrectinib)
- Xofigo® (radium Ra 223 dichloride)

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
